will be held in Koper at the Faculty of Education on Friday, 20 September 2019

Theme: The Role of Kindergarten in Educating a Child of the First Age Period

In recent decades, we have witnessed a major shift in understanding the notion of childhood, the child's needs and rights. The shift is a consequence and a reason for research into the factors of development and learning of children in the earliest period of their lives: from birth to the age of three. In this period, the children's innate cognitive research ability and activity is linked in a particularly prominent way with (i) the development and expression of their potentials and consequently (ii) the increased needs for a responsive and experience-based rich environment.

The latter represents the guiding principle in providing a stimulating learning environment in which a child has the opportunity to create diverse interactions with his/her ideas, with other children, adults and the content of the material environment. Although the purpose of the academic meeting reaches beyond finding a link between the quality of preschool education for instrumentalized provision of effects in later periods of life, studies report positive, long-term effects (such as more successful

lifelong learning, social integration and higher employability) of quality preschool education up to the early adulthood of an individual.

The purpose of the 15th International Academic Meeting is to stimulate research and critical discussion on the quality of education in kindergarten groups of the first age period in different sociocultural settings. We want to connect different research approaches with the planning, implementation and evaluation of pedagogical practices in all areas of a child's development and learning.

Within the framework of the 15th International Academic Meeting, we have developed the following thematic areas:

- Early childhood education up to the age of 3;
- The role of an adult in early childhood education serving children up to the age of 3;
- Psychosocial characteristics of a baby and a toddler;
- Research in kindergarten up to the age of 3.
